FROM FATHER GEORGE REGARDING HOLY WEEK AND PASCHA:

Christ is Risen! And all the world rejoices! We, here at All Saints, rejoiced and enjoyed a particularly blessed and beautiful Holy Week and Pascha. We were especially blessed that Fr. John Filipovich was able to be with us, assisting me for all the lengthy services. (Or was I assisting Fr. John?)

The beautiful and moving services of Holy Week culminated in the glorious celebration of Pascha. There were so many individuals who helped with the preparations, cleaning, cooking, singing, processing and serving at the altar. The list would take up the whole bulletin. However, I would like to mention some of the things that were done: (1). complete repair and polishing of the seven branch candelabra as well as other candle stands, the censers and other items in the altar area, (2). a new tomb for the Plashchinitsa (Shroud), (3). the setting out of the luminarias for the processions, (4). the complete cleaning of the kitchen, the preparation and serving of the food and the cleanup after the meal, (5). the ordering and setting up of the beautiful flowers, decoration of the tomb, and decoration of the cross for Pascha, (6). the setting up and taking down of tables and chairs and cleaning up afterwards, (7). all the time and effort of those who prepared the music, rehearsed and sang the beautiful services. *God Himself will thank each of you, in the way in which only He can.*
