FATHER GEORGE WISHES THAT ALL OF US PLEASE BEAR IN MIND that appropriate dress is required at the Divine Liturgy at all times. Shorts on men or women and short skirts and plunging necklines have never been considered appropriate.

While most Orthodox Christians are perhaps aware of the general rules of fasting for Great Lent, the rules for the other fasting periods are less known. During the **DORMITION FAST**, wine and oil are allowed only on Saturdays and Sundays and fish, wine & oil are allowed only on the **Feast of the Transfiguration**, August 6th; the **Feast of St Herman of Alaska**, August 9th; and the **Feast of St Tikhon of Zadonsk**, August 13th.

If you are able, we particularly try to stand during the processions with the Gospel and the Gifts, during the Readings, the Creed, during the preparation of the Holy Eucharist, the Lord's Prayer and reception of Communion. * **We invite you** to stay after the Thanksgiving Prayers **for fellowship** and coffee, so that we may greet you personally, and to answer any questions you may have about our faith, our parish or today's service. * Please help yourself to the brochures and information on the Literature Table. * All children **ages three through twelve** are encouraged to attend our Sunday School after Holy Communion. * **We hope you will visit us again.**

THE BLESSING OF FIRST FRUITS traditionally begins on the Great Feast of the Transfiguration (August 6th.) with the blessing of grapes. In localities where grapes are not grown, other early-ripening fruits such as apples may be offered. There is a special ceremony at the end of the Divine Liturgy at which the priest blesses the first fruits, asking *...that the Lord may bless them, that they may be to us unto rejoicing, and that He may accept a gift of these fruits unto the cleansing of our sins...* As the harvest season progresses, the first fruits of each species can be brought to the church to be blessed, using a similar format, but a different prayer: *...that the Lord may receive our gift unto His eternal treasury and grant us an abundance of earthly goods...*
